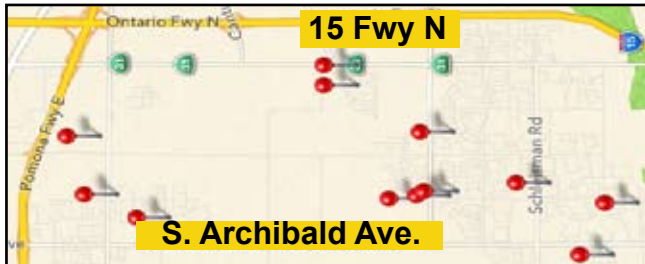

Eastvale - Eastvale has collaborated with the sheriff dept. to help catch criminals through its new Persons Of Interest program.

Crime prevention cannot be

achieved by the police alone, according to a City of Eastvale news release. The Eastvale Police Dept. has established a 24 hour crime tip line dedicated to allowing the public to report information that might help the police track and find persons of

interest, which may possibly be witnesses and/or suspects. The tip line is designed to be anonymous because the community is often afraid to report

Eastvale - Eastvale residents have raised concerns about the amount of dogs running around the city without a leash or an owner.

"It's a big problem," Eastvale

Mayor Ike Bootsma said in a recent interview. "It seems as though people feel that when animal control isn't around, they can let their dogs run free."

Most of the incidents occur after 5 p.m. when animal control agents can't respond, according

to the City. Animal control's policy is to only respond to emergencies, like a dog attack, after 5 p.m. However, the City may authorize the City Man-

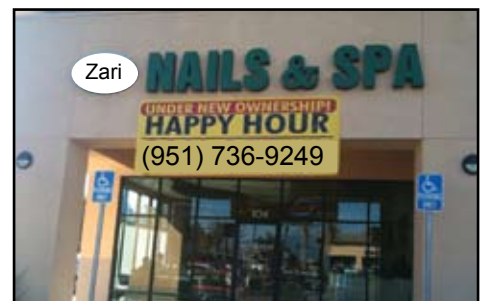

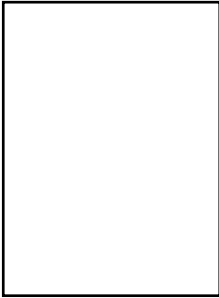

Public Works Department Maintaining a First Rate Infrastructure System!

The Public Works Department is responsible for constructing and maintaining the City's infrastructure which includes 1,178 miles of streets, sidewalks, 41 traffic signals, storm drains less than 36" in size, all traffic signs, and one bridge. Public Works ensures that our

streets are safe and clean; traffic signals operate efficiently, the staff responds to citizen concerns in the public right-of-way, as well as provide quality and responsive private development plan review. The City of Eastvale utilizes the services of the County of Riverside for routine street maintenance, traffic signal maintenance, and traffic sign repair and replacement. County staff provides fast response times and quality work. The City's public works staff is responsible for implementing capital improvement programs to maintain and expand the City's infrastructure as needed. Maintaining 1,178 miles of

roadway is no small challenge. The City has developed a pavement management plan and 5 year capital improvement program to systematically maintain all City infrastructure. Over the next 5 years, it is estimated that the City will spend over \$4.6 million dollars on improvements to City facilities. City infrastructure is maintained through specific funding sources such as Measure A and Gas Tax funds and is not funded through the General Fund. The Building Division is responsible for enforcing local state and federal laws enacted to safeguard public safety, health and the general welfare

through the California Building Code. The Division is responsible for reviewing documents, issuing permits and enforcement of the Building Codes. Every building in the City of Eastvale is inspected by City building inspectors. These inspections ensure that the structures are safe and meet all applicable codes. In addition, for homeowner improvements such as patio covers, pools, remodels and other improvements to property

may require a permit. To find out before you construct, call City Hall to determine whether a permit is required. Should you have any questions or comments, City Hall may be reached at Hall (951) 361-0900. City Hall office hours are Monday-Thursday from 7:30 am – 5:30 pm, closed every Friday. City Hall encourages all residents and visitors to register for e-notification on the City's website: www.EastvaleCA.gov.

Beware of Non-Permitted Curb Painters

Eastvale - Residents have reported that curb painters have been soliciting in neighborhoods, offering to repaint curb addresses

for a fee. Although this is routine maintenance that residents may need to complete every so often, homeowners are encouraged to confirm that those offering the service are authorized and per-

mitted to be conducting business within the City of Eastvale. Permitted curb painters will typically leave a flyer with contact information in an effort to secure business. In some cas-

es, non-permitted painters will distribute flyers in areas, paint the curbs, and then go back and solicit payment for work. If a problem occurs in the community, authorities know how

to reach a permitted business owner to resolve an issue. Residents approached by non-permitted curb painters are asked to call the Code Enforcement Department at 951-361-2888.

Did YOU Know???

CITY OF EASTVALE

According to Municipal Code section 120.050.080 (d) (1) c-d Trash, garbage, recycling or green waste containers (cans, bins, boxes or other such containers) shall not be kept in any front yard, driveway, walkway, sidewalk, street or right-of-way for more than 36 sequential hours in any seven-day period, including trash and recycling pickup day. Trash containers used for construction or remodeling of the property shall be exempt provided that they are removed within 45 days following issuance of building permits, unless additional time is granted or approved by the department of building and safety. For single-family residential developments, the trash or recycling containers shall be stored in garage, side yard or rear yard, in a manner that they are not visible from any public street.

Sex offenders register

by law to register with law enforcement agencies to make their whereabouts public on www.meganslaw.ca.gov.

Thanks to Megan's Law, the public is able to search to be aware of sex offenders in their city and better protect their families. Registered sex offenders are not allowed to live within 500 feet from any school or park, and are not allowed in a zone between 1000-2500 feet (depending on your state) where children congregate.

Megan's Law passed legislation stating that every sex offender must register with their local law enforcement agency. Before August 2004, the information was only available if requested personally or by calling a toll-free number. However, after September 2004, the public has been able to view this information via the internet. The website was designed to list all sex offenders in California, and was named after Megan Kanka, a 7 year old from New Jersey, who was raped and killed by Jesse Timmendequas, a neighbor who had moved across the street from the family. Timmendequas was a convicted sex offender and the Kanka family was unaware of this.

In the City of Eastvale, there are total of 20 cases of report-

ed registered sex offenders. In the 91752 zip code, there are 3 registered offenders, while in the larger area of Eastvale, 92880, there are 17.

Surrounding cities rank higher than Eastvale. Chino Hills has 24 sex offenders registered, Ontario has 172, Norco has 24, Corona has 107, and Riverside has 383.

The Megans Law website contains a map where the public is able to navigate and see any convicted individuals and detail information of their crimes. According to the website, there is one registered sex offender around Hamner Avenue and Jamestown Ave, five registered sex offender around Limonite and 65th Street, and two offenders next to each other near Lake Springs Street east of Hamner Ave. Complete data is also available on www.meganslaw.ca.gov, where residents can surf the website and be aware when walking children to school, or when children play outside. Many apps have been created to facilitate the information to those who have smart phones, and alerts can be sent directly to the smart phone whenever you approach a sex offender's location.

There are many ways to care for your family, and Megan's law is one way to ensure the safety of your little ones.

crime information or identify photographs of suspects/witnesses because they fear re-

prisal from the person they are reporting. This hotline will give members of our community the ability to provide confidential information to their police department and at the same time make our community safer.

ager to call out Animal Control services on a non-emergency basis, at a two hour minimum of \$82 per hour.

Eastvale does have a leash law within the city and fines aren't cheap. According to Animal Control, the fine for dog owners who let their dogs run loose is \$119 for a first offense.

Mayor Ike Bootsma said that he would like to have animal services rotate its patrols between daytime, evenings and weekends.

"Most of the stray dogs are out in the evenings and on weekends when animal control is not out here," he said.

At the City Council meeting of January 9, 2012, the City Council requested an update of the contract with the County of Riverside for Animal Control and Field Services.

The City entered into an agreement with the County for Animal Control and Field Services effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2014. The agreement specifies a basic level of service and also provides for additional

services at the discretion of the City including Animal Control Sweeps, Shot Clinics, and Licensing Services. To date, the City has not requested nor paid for these additional services.

The service agreement with animal control calls for a half-time animal control officer and animal shelter services at a flat rate of \$138 per day. The officer is in Eastvale from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. or from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., for a total of 20 hours per week.

So far, 11 dogs have been reported to be lost or found on our Facebook page (www.

Frequently Asked Tire Questions

STAFF REPORTS

Eastvale – As the rainy season ends and the summer months approach us, it's important to pay attention to your tires. Here are a few tire tips provided by Chris Mitsos, President of Mountain View Tires, located at 6080 Hamner Avenue in Eastvale. Remember: regardless how expensive your car is, the tires are the ones that keep you rolling.

How often should I have my tires rotated?

To make it more convenient for you and ensure that it's

done regularly, we suggest having your tires rotated each time you have your oil changed. (When you buy your tires at Mountain View Tire, you'll get free rotation as long they're on your vehicle.) At the very least, your tires should be rotated every 8,000 miles.

How much air should I put in my tires?

There's no one answer for all vehicles, but no matter what you drive, you should be able to find the correct tire pressure for your vehicle in the owner's manual and on the metal plaque at the end of the

driver's side door. Don't rely on the pressure listed on the sidewall of the tire. That's the maximum pressure for that tire, and may not be the right pressure for your car or truck.

Do my new tires need to be the same size as my current tires?

Never buy replacement tires that are smaller than your vehicle's original tires. Smaller tires may not be able to support the loaded weight of the vehicle. Tires should always be replaced with the same size designation - or the approved options - recom-



mended by the vehicle or tire manufacturer.

Can I mix tire types on my car?

Driving on different tires (different size designations, constructions, amounts of wear, etc.) may affect vehicle handling and stability. For the best all-around performance, use the same type of tire on all four wheel positions. Special purpose tires (such as snow

tires) can be used to improve performance in some applications. Other tires (such as speed-rated constructions) may also have special matching requirements. A Mountain View Tire representative can provide the specific information you need

Eastvale Resident, Officer And His K-9 Killed In Fatal Car Accident

By: ANDREW HOOVER

Eastvale -A correctional officer, who is also a resident of Eastvale, was killed alongside his K-9 in a fatal car accident.

On Mar. 25, Gilbert Cortez, 46, and his K-9 Mattie were in a fatal rollover crash on route 79 in the Warner Springs area. Cortez was leading three other K-9 teams in separate cars down state highway 79 in San Diego county on their way to conduct a contraband search of La Cima Fire Camp, stated a corrections department news release. Cortez’s vehicle was ahead of the oth-

ers when it began drifting to the right, the officer overcorrected and crossed the highway. The vehicle then rolled and careened into an embankment. Cortez died before he could be airlifted to the hospital. The cause of the accident is still under investigation.

“All of us at CDCR mourn the tragic death of Officer Gilbert Cortez,” said California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) Secretary Jeff Beard. “He was a valued member of our department and his untimely passing, in the line of duty, is a huge loss to all who worked with him. Our thoughts and prayers are with Gil’s

family, friends and colleagues. We are also deeply saddened by the death of Gil’s K-9 partner, Mattie.”

Cortez worked at California Rehabilitation Center (CRC) and was part of the Southern Regional K-9 Unit. He started his career at CDCR in 1990 at the California Institution for Men. The next year, he transferred to Calipatria State Prison where he was assigned to the Investigative Services Unit and promoted to the rank of Sergeant. In 2001, Cortez was transferred to CRC where he subsequently completed K-9 training. He is survived by his wife, children, and parents.

His K-9 partner, Mattie, was a Belgian Malinois, donated by a private citizen in the San Diego area. She started service with Officer Cortez in August 2011 and was certified to search for contraband and narcotics. CDCR’s K-9 program uses dogs and skilled handlers to detect cell phones and drugs in prisons.

A news release from California Governor Jerry Brown stated that flags at the state capitol in Sacramento would be flown at half-mast to honor Cortez.

“We are grateful for his courage and years of service to the people of California,” Brown said in the statement.

Ontario resident Jeffrey Langenhorst ended the pursuit in Eastvale, where he refused to step out of a tractor trailer when asked by San Bernardino County Sheriffs and Chino Police. This

The incident started when Chino Police Officers spotted an individual that matched the description of a wanted fugitive by investigators.

San Bernardino County Sheriff’s spokesman Randy Naquin said “after refusing to pull over for failure to yield, the officers began the pursuit.” The pursuit lead officers through three

freeways. The suspected fugitive also crashed into a patrol vehicle as well a civilian vehicle, and it was determined that he was driving in speeds up to 90 mph.

Langenhorst exited the I-15 freeway and lost control of his vehicle in Eastvale. Langenhorst fled on foot and jumped into a tractor trailer. Naquin said that Langenhorst was warned to step out of the tractor and surrender peacefully; however, Langenhorst did not.

When Langenhorst refused the officers request, the officers opened fire.

Langenhorst was pronounced dead on the 4200 block of Hamner Ave. According to Naquin, whether or not Langenhorst died instantly or not is still under investigation. On Mar. 17, it was released that Langenhorst was wanted on a federal arrest warrant.

No further information has been released.

Norco Guard Pleads Not Guilty

Norco - A security guard, who most recently worked at Norco High School, pleaded not guilty to sexual harassment allegations against him while he was a coach at Eisenhower High School.

Floyd Eddings Jr, 55, also a former NFL wide receiver for the New York Giants, was arrested and has pled not

guilty to sexual harassment claims recently filed against him by two victims.

Eddings was employed as a Norco High security guard when he was arrested, so the Norco-Corona School District had sent Eddings on administrative leave without pay due to the charges filed against him. The District stated in a recent interview that their primary concern is the safety of the

children at the schools.

Eddings was taken from his Rialto home, located in the 600 block of North Briewood Ave., on Thurs. Mar 7 after two victims came forward. The victims said that he sexually abused them during his coaching career at Eisenhower. Eddings coached girls basketball, track-and-field sports and at one time, was the freshman football head coach while

erside Police Department, had issued search warrants for 26 houses. 15 of the 26 houses were industrial sized grow houses featuring full hydroponic growing equipment, as well as stolen electricity obtained with a sophisticated electrical bypass of the utility meters.

When the DEA conducted the raids, authorities seized more than \$250k in cash, 7 guns including an assault rifle, and more than 8k marijuana plants.

These raids were conducted after the first marijuana grow houses were found in Eastvale last year. On Feb. 10, 2012, the DEA and officers with the Riverside County Sheriff’s Department executed a search warrant on Cedar Creek Road in Eastvale, when they discovered a residence that had been completely converted

into a sophisticated marijuana grow house. During the search, they seized more than 1,800 marijuana plants and more than 50 pounds of processed marijuana. There was a sophisticated electrical bypass system that was used to divert from the meter the electricity used to power the ballasts and lights to grow the marijuana plants.

In November 2012, another search was conducted at a residence on Bluebell Street in Eastvale, where authorities discovered that the entire residence had been converted into industrial-sized marijuana grow with 857 marijuana plants. Approximately 43 pounds of marijuana were found inside the residence.

After these houses were found, an investigation occurred that lead to the 26 house raids last month and the arrest of 10 out of 11 people. Among these arrests was the ring leader of the marijuana traf-

ficking ring Raymond Lam, 42 of Arcadia, who also used the name “Nam A Lam”, who is accused of being the leader of the organization and overseeing the acquisition of residences that were converted into full scale, industrial-type grow houses, which included 1000-2000 plants per house.

The others were the lieutenants of the operation which included Simon Lam, 32 of Arcadia; Ken Ho also known as “Ken Lam”, 33 of Arcadia; San S. Voong, also known as Chen Sheng Wang, 35 of Arcadia; Phieu Tran, 35 of El Monte; Augustine Bazan Camacho, 41 of Pomona who was allegedly a veteran “plant tender” who was responsible for maintaining many of the grow houses; Thanh Van Phu, 33 of El Monte; and Luc Kai Phoung, also known as “Wong Fong,” “Al Fong” and “Na Na,” 50, of Rosemead, who allegedly built the electrical and utility meter by-pass systems used at the grow houses, and

Li Ya Si, 42, of Temple City. The eleventh suspect, Andy Tran, 39 of Monterey Park, who used several aliases including “Long Kim Tank”, was allegedly a top lieutenant of Lam, is a fugitive and currently being sought by authorities.

The narcotics conspiracy charge in the indictment carries a statutory maximum penalty of life and a mandatory minimum sentence of 10 years in a federal prison.

Then a little eight-year-old voice piped up from the back, "Dear Jesus, don't let Tommy get killed, okay? That's all. Okay. Amen." The sanctuary fell silent, as everyone suddenly knew that the prayers they had encrusted in adult euphemisms had really been grown-up attempts to say this one thing: "Don't let Tommy get killed, okay?" It took a child to express what adults couldn't.

When Robbie Castleman, author of Parenting in the Pew, told that story, it reminded me of something I heard Andre Koley, one of the top illusionists in the

world, say: "The hardest people in all the world to fool with your tricks are children." That's because children aren't as complex as adults in trying to figure something out. They just see it for what it is. They're not filtering the solution through so many possibilities.

The next time you pray, get real. Get real simple. Be real honest. Get real with God. With total reverence for God, tell Him what you'd really like to tell Him.

I believe God breaks out in a big grin when we get real with Him.


