CH “Maternity Hotel” For Sale

Chino Hills – The Chino Hills house that was formerly used as a “Maternity Hotel” is now up for sale for millions.

The 7,964-square foot mansion located at 15250 Woodglen Drive in Chino Hills has been on the market for about three weeks, priced at \$3.3 million.

The house is listed on the market as a 1974 Spanish style on 5.88 acres of land with 7 bedrooms, 7 baths, and a 6 car garage. The two story home listing mentioned many features, including, a cabana patio, a deck,

a private spa, a panoramic view, and a fireplace in the dining room, family room and in the master bedroom.

However, many real estate experts are saying the house may be difficult to sell because of the house’s celebrity status for the past couple months, according to local reports. The Chino Hills residential home was across headlines as being turned into a Chinese maternity hotel,

Former DB Honda Land Use Analyzed

Diamond Bar - The former Diamond Bar Honda dealership building as well as the land it’s on, is currently being discussed by the Diamond Bar City Council on what the land will be used for.

Last month, the city approved a contract to do a market analysis on what type of businesses

would be best suited for the property at Grand Ave. and the 57/60 freeway interchange. With the dealership being closed since 2006 as well as the Burger King that was closed Jan. 31, the property is completely vacant. However, back in April 2012, the council adopted an interim ordinance on the land that came with a 45 day moratorium on issuing land use permits.

In May 2012, the council held another meeting which extended the moratorium an additional 10 months and 15 days to provide additional time to conduct research and propose changes to the City’s Development Code.

The city staff has begun working with AECOM on the

Something In The Water At Chino High

Chino - Chino High School’s drinking water is exhibiting an odd taste and color, however Officials with the San Bernardino County Department of Public Health states that there are no real health concerns.

Chino High’s aging plumbing system was tested on March 31. The tests came back positive for lead, but at a number below the state health maximum of 15 parts

per billion (ppb). One site in the school’s staff lounge detected 16 ppb. The staff then replaced the old faucet with a new certified lead free faucet, according to the U.S. EPA guidelines.

Chino High was built in 1964 and has still maintained it’s original plumbing. The original plumbing consists of metal pipes that will sometimes produce an orange tinge in the water.

The school’s water system is not the only problem. Parents

have issued formal complaints about the state of the school including how badly the boys and girls locker rooms are rundown, paint peeling, urinals and sinks leaking, broken lockers and damaged floors. However, the water system seems to be the most pressing issue.

Most of the schools in Chino use an old piping system and

Woman Found Guilty Of Murder

Pomona - A 27 year-old woman was found guilty three

counts of murder in connection to the fatal traffic death of a man and his pregnant girlfriend. Lorraine Martinez, Pomona,

was found guilty on Mar. 21 on three counts of murder after fatally crashing into and killing a man and his pregnant girlfriend back on Aug. 1, 2011.

Martinez was originally sentenced to jail on two misdemeanor charges on July 29, 2011 for being in possession of methamphetamine and brandishing a deadly weapon: a pipe. Martinez was sentenced and sent to jail until July 31 2011.

On Aug. 1 2011, Martinez stole an Infiniti G37 and fled down Holt Ave. going at a high rate of speed and broadsided a Nissan

Maximathat was turning left into a restaurant. The impact was enough to tear the Maxima in two, crash into a telephone pole and catch fire. Inside the Maxima was Miguel Herrera, 22, his pregnant girlfriend, Desiree Grajeda, 17, and their unborn son, identified in the criminal complaint as "Baby Grajeda."

The car was allegedly stolen from her boyfriend, according to authorities.

Martinez, who is to be sentenced on April 16, is facing 45 years to life in state prison with a possibility of parole.

preparation of a municipal highest and best use analysis of the Honda property in accordance with the Professional Services Agreement approved by the City Council on March 5, 2013, according to city documents. The study will take 12 to 16 weeks to complete, and will provide the foundation for a land use strategy and new zoning regulations to guide the establishment of new uses that would support the goal of yielding the highest municipal

returns, while generating sufficient private returns to be of interest to the private development community.

The ban, which expires this month, will be discussed by the City Council at their next city council meeting. The meeting will be focused on whether or not to extend the ban on land use permits. If the ban gets extended, it would give the city enough time to complete its market analysis, according to a staff report issued by the city.

Plans for the property are further being complicated by the proposed stadium in Industry due to the reworking of

the freeway on-ramp being revamped by Caltrans. Grand Ave. sees around 40,000 trips a day in traffic and the 57 and 60 freeways sees about 350,000 trips a day.

The analysis will look at potential uses with and without a NFL stadium next door.

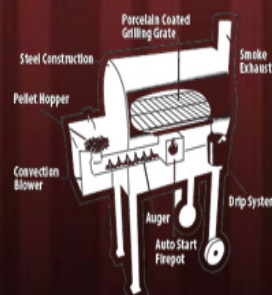



houses were industrial sized grow houses featuring full hydroponic growing equipment, as well as stolen electricity obtained with a sophisticated electrical bypass of the utility meters.

When the DEA conducted the raids, authorities seized more than \$250k in cash, 7 guns including an assault rifle, and more than 8k marijuana plants.

These raids were conducted after the first marijuana grow houses were found in Eastvale last year. On Feb. 10, 2012, the DEA and officers with the Riverside County Sheriff's Department executed a search warrant on Cedar Creek Road in Eastvale, when they discovered a residence that had been completely converted into a sophisticated marijuana grow house. During the search, they seized more than 1,800 marijuana plants and more than 50 pounds of processed marijuana. There was a sophisticated electrical bypass system that was used to divert from the meter the electricity used to power the ballasts and lights to grow the marijuana plants.

In November 2012, another search was conducted at a residence on Bluebell Street in Eastvale, where authorities discovered that the entire residence had been converted into industrial-sized marijuana grow with 857 marijuana plants. Approximately 43 pounds of marijuana were found inside the residence.

After these houses were found, an investigation occurred that led to the 26 house raids last month and the arrest of 10 out of 11 people. Among these arrests was the ring leader of the marijuana trafficking ring Raymond Lam, 42 of Arcadia, who also used the name "Nam A Lam", who is accused of being the leader of the organization and overseeing the acquisition of residences that were

converted into full scale, industrial-type grow houses, which included 1000-2000 plants per house.

The others were the lieutenants of the operation which included Simon Lam, 32 of Arcadia; Ken Ho also known as "Ken Lam", 33 of Arcadia; San S. Voong, also known as Chen Sheng Wang, 35 of Arcadia; Phieu Tran, 35 of El Monte; Augustine Bazan Camacho, 41 of Pomona who

was allegedly a veteran "plant tender" who was responsible for maintaining many of the grow houses; Thanh Van Phu, 33 of El Monte; and Luc Kai Phoung, also known as "Wong Fong," "Al Fong" and "Na Na," 50, of Rosemead, who allegedly built the electrical and utility meter by-pass systems used at the grow houses, and Li Ya Si, 42, of Temple City. The eleventh suspect, Andy Tran,

39 of Monterey Park, who used several aliases including "Long Kim Tank", was allegedly a top lieutenant of Lam, is a fugitive and currently being sought by authorities.

The narcotics conspiracy charge in the indictment carries a statutory maximum penalty of life and a mandatory minimum sentence of 10 years in a federal prison.

child. The defendant was facing a maximum sentence of five years in state prison.

At the time of the crimes, Serrano worked as a boxing coach at Santa Ana Boxing Club. Serrano met both of his victims through the boxing club.

Between May and October 2006, Serrano sexually assaulted John Doe #1 beginning when the victim was 14 years old. Serrano committed lewd acts

against John Doe #1 on more than one occasion in Serrano's home.

John Doe #1 reported the sexual assault in 2008, but the case was not filed at that time due to insufficient corroboration.

Between May 2011 and April 2012, Serrano sexually assaulted John Doe #2 beginning when the victim was 14-years-old. Serrano committed lewd acts against John Doe #2 on more than one occasion in Serrano's home.

John Doe #2 reported the sexual abuse to the Santa Ana

Police Department, who investigated this case, on July 15, 2012.

At the sentencing, John Doe #2 delivered a victim impact statement before the court describing how the sexual abuse from the defendant has affected his life and talked about how he regularly attends therapy sessions because of the trauma caused by the sexual assault. John Doe #2's mother also

delivered a victim impact statement before the court describing how the defendant made up lies by accusing the victim of being a liar and making the sexual assaults up in order to cover up the abuse.

Serrano's lifetime sex offender registration bars him from entering County recreational areas and City parks which

have passed the Sex Offender Ordinance. Visit www.orange-countyda.com to read the prior press releases on the County's Sex Offender Ordinance as well as the 14 other cities that have enacted the Child Safety Zone Ordinance.

Deputy District Attorney Keith Burke of the Sexual Assault Unit prosecuted this case

forcement law.

City staff inspected the property through a court order on Nov. 19 and a public complaint was filed on Dec. 7. Through the court-ordered inspection, city officials discovered that the home was allegedly being used to house 30 pregnant Chinese women that came from China to give birth on United States soil.

The inspection also revealed that a resident was charged \$150 a day for a medium-size room. An invoice showed another tenant paid \$27,000 for her prenatal and postpartum care.

The “hotel” had been reported to be offering \$5,000 to \$15,000 packages, according to notinchinohills.org. These packages included transportation, meals,

tours, and a hospital stay before returning to China with their American-born babies.

Officials also observed raw sewage “flowing down” the property and determined that the septic system was failing, according to a city report.

Through property meter readings, the city was able to determine that more than 100,000 gallons of water, or an average of 4,000 gallons per day, was being used at the facility from Sept. through Dec 2012. Septic systems in that area were designed to handle only 1,500 gallons a day, almost one third of the current use, the complaint said.

The city also observed a dining area, dining schedule, a “lobby”, recreation areas, a luggage dolly, and brochures advertising the hotel as “USA Los Angeles Hermas Inter-

national Guidance on How to Have an American Baby,” the complaint said.

Chino Hills City Mayor, Peter Rogers, said that until the 14th Amendment of the Constitution is amended or eliminated, what was done by the operators of these birthing tourism programs was not illegal, according to the City Council meeting minutes. The 14th Amendment of the United States Constitution states a child born in the US is granted citizenship and will receive a birth certificate. However, the house did have many code violations.

The inspection report also indicated the home had been subdivide, without proper permits, lacked emergency escape windows, unpermitted gas lines for a secondary kitchen, no smoke detectors or carbon monoxide

detectors, and unpermitted electrical and plumbing connections in the 17 room facility. Rooms also resembled a hotel, with matching monograms, keyed locks on each door, and water buckets to wash with.

The City of Chino Hills filed a temporary restraining order against the owners of the house, Hai Yong Wu and Yi Wang, in December because attorneys were unable to serve the homeowners.

The Court order prevented Wu and Wang, and their company Los Angeles Hermas Inc, from entering the property and performing any construction at the home without first obtaining a permit from the city.

A court date in January allowed Wu and Wang to defend them-

selves from a preliminary injunction by the city, according to the city, but neither their lawyers nor Wu and Wang appeared in court.

Despite the failed court appearance, city officials and Wu’s attorney entered into an agreement that says they have 210 days to bring the home to code or they will face fines.

Although the property is on the market, the owners are still responsible for correcting the violations prior to its sale. If they do not, they must disclose the violations to the new owner to avoid a fraudulent transaction. This may affect the sale price tremendously.

The house must also sell and close escrow within the 210 days or the owners will have to fix the violations themselves.

Something in the water at Chino High

replacing it wouldn’t be cheap, according to the City of Chino. The work wouldn’t just involve replacing pipes in the walls and the ceiling, its underground water supply lines come out of the city’s main system and are all made from the same material. Replacing just the pipes in Chino High would help, but not fully remedy the problem since the pipes underground are made of the same material. Replacing the City’s main piping system would also cost millions of dollars, according to the City of Chino.

While replacing the pipes would be a very costly and extensive project, the school hopes to have funding or access to funding soon to achieve an updated plumbing system for the school. However, there are still concerns about the aging plumbing system which gives the water an odd flavor and

color.

It would take over \$270 billion just to return American schools to working condition, according to the Center For Green

Schools. They also estimate that it would require \$542 billion over the next 10 years to modernize Pre-K through 12th grade schools.
