The duties of the Commander are overseeing and directing the activities of patrol officers within geographic areas; coordinating detectives' investigative efforts within the county; and, exercising functional supervision over officers engaged in traffic enforcement functions. ## Industry Receives New Police Chief

**Industry** – A new Police Chief has been assigned to the City of Industry Sheriff's Department.

Tim Murakami of Rosemead has been named the next Industry Chief of Police and is the first Chief of Police coming from Rosemead, CA. Murakami also sustained the role of Lieutenant for the Rosemead Police Station because the City of Rosemead contracts with the LA County

Sheriff's Department.

Murakami made himself known through the station by doing activities such as working in a gang task force primarily for Asian gangs. The Asian Crime Task Force was formed in the early 2000s as a way to address the needs of the Asian community and to build trust between the community and the Sheriff's Department. As a result, the team of 30 deputies specialized in dealing with Asian street

gangs, organized crime, and victims of crime.

Murakami also assumes the role as liaison between the City and the Sheriff's Department. Murakami will direct the operations of the City's Public Safety Department, which is composed of both law enforcement officers from the Sheriff's Department and City Civilian Support Per-

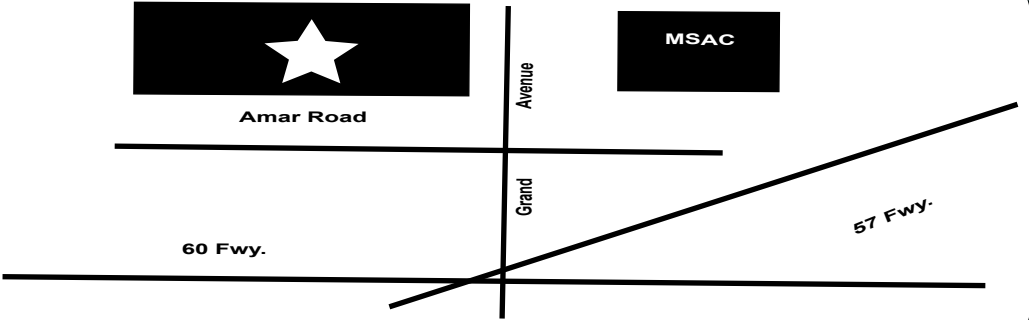

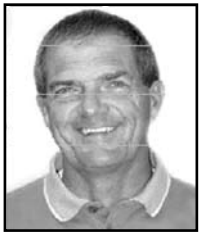

the Norco Community Oriented Policing and Problem Solving (COPPS) team.  
During the investigation, the

detectives and deputies found that one of the suspects, identified as Callum Huskey, 30 of Norco, had an outstanding no-bail felony warrant. While under interrogation, Huskey was identified as a possible suspect

wanted in connection to two commercial robberies that occurred within the City of Norco in August of 2012.  
The Jurupa Valley detectives did a subsequent investigation into the robberies and positively

identified Huskey as the suspect wanted in the robberies, investigators also found the name of Huskey's accomplice, Donna Stewart, 54 of Norco.  
Huskey and Stewart were both arrested with the following charg-

es: two counts of kidnapping to commit robbery and conspiracy, and two counts of conspiracy for kidnapping to commit robbery. They were both booked into the Robert Presley Detention Center with bail set at \$1 million.

on March 4 to three years in federal prison.

In addition to the prison terms, United States District Judge Cormac J. Carney ordered the Fus to pay \$4.7 million in restitution.

The Fus owned Anaheim-based Galleria USA, Inc., which imported home decor items manufactured in China. The Fus obtained a \$130 million revolving line of credit for Galleria from a consortium of seven banks. In connection with that revolving line of credit, the couple overstated by tens of millions of dollars the accounts receivables of the company – lies they told the banks in order to continue borrowing funds under the revolving line of credit, according to court documents. When they pleaded

guilty last year, the Fus also admitted to falsifying in Galleria's computer system the accounts receivable amounts by a factor of 10 or more times the actual amount purchased to support the exaggerated numbers and hide Galleria's true financial status.

"Bank fraud is not a victimless crime as it has detrimental effects on both creditors and consumers," said United States Attorney André Birotte Jr. "The Fus plundered a consortium of banks, which deprived legitimate customers from having access to the those funds and caused the financial institutions to suffer millions of dollars in losses. The prison sentences issued to this couple demonstrate our resolve to hold fraudsters accountable for their crimes."

The banks suffered losses of \$4.7 million on the revolving line

of credit from October 2008 to July 2009.

This case was investigated by the Office of the Special Inspector General for the Troubled Asset Relief Program (SIGTARP), the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the United States Secret Service.

"At a time when taxpayers were bailing out Bank of America and United Commercial Bank with TARP funds, Thomas and Cheri Fu defrauded those banks and others out of nearly \$5 million," said Christy Romero, Special Inspector General for TARP (SIGTARP). "The Fus fraudulently obtained funds from the TARP

banks and other banks using a second set of books that overstated accounts receivable. They lived comfortably off the money, buying property and putting their daughter through college, when many taxpayers who funded the bailout were tightening their belts. Illegally profiting from the TARP bailout is reprehensible and will be met

with swift justice by SIGTARP and our law enforcement partners."

contact with civic leaders and community groups within their geographic bureaus to promote the goals and missions of the Sheriff's Department to encourage neighborhood watch safety programs and to generate input from citizens to establish mutual trust between police officers and the community. Also, the commander is responsible for ensuring compliance with department policies and procedures by personnel under his/her supervision; conducting audits of operations; and, making recommendations to higher management for improving productivity and increasing efficiency. Further, the Commander may act as a Chief's Duty Officer during off-hours or a Deputy Chief in his/her absence and carry out duties specified by the Chief of Police.

Captain David Halm began his career with the Sheriff's Department in 1983 with his first assignment to the Inmate Reception Center. He transferred to Lake-wood Station where he worked primarily in the City of Bellflower and soon was assigned as a field training officer. He continued training newly assigned deputies for a full five years. He was pro-

moted to sergeant in 1994 and remained working for the City of Bellflower.

In 1997, he transferred to the Sheriff's Headquarters Bureau where he worked as a media liaison until his promotion to lieutenant in 2000. He was transferred to Cerritos Station, where he served as the Patrol Watch Commander for nearly three years. In early 2003, he transferred to the Operations Bureau, where he was assigned as the operations lieutenant. In mid 2004, he was assigned as the second-in-command, Operations Lieutenant at the Walnut/Diamond Bar Station, where he served the communities of Walnut, Diamond Bar, Rowland Heights and Covina

Hills for the last three and half years before his subsequent promotion to Station Captain on July 1, 2007.

Captain Halm was also one of the highest ranking captains amongst the station personnel, gaining much support amongst all the officers within the department in an anonymous vote. "That's a hard thing to do," chuckled Lt Blasnek, who has worked with Halm for years.

"For now, Commander Halm is filling two positions," said Lt. Blasnek. "He will be the Commander to the region and he will still be filling the Captain position at our Walnut Station, until we find a new Captain."
