Local High Schools Ranked Best in US

Walnut - Diamond Bar and Walnut High Schools have been ranked as two of the best in the state and nation in the 2013 U.S. News Best High Schools Rankings released on April 22.

The outstanding schools are in the top 10% of high schools in the state and top 3% nationwide.

Diamond Bar High School received the Gold Medal Award.

DBHS is ranked 39th within California and 219th in the nation.

"Congratulations to our students, staff, and parents in building and supporting such a wonderful learning community for our children!" said DBHS Principal Catherine Real.

"If you look closely at how the rankings were compiled, you will see that among other criteria, our school philosophy of open access to AP courses and AP testing has played a big part in

how well we ranked. Not only have we increased access to more AP courses, but we have simultaneously maintained an excellent pass rate!" Real said.

Walnut High School received the Silver Medal Award. WHS is ranked 122nd within California and 629th in the nation.

Plastic Task Force Seize 30K Of Stolen Plastic

Industry - The Industry Plastic Industrial Theft Task Force (PITTF) identified and seized a warehouse containing stolen trademarked plastic goods with an estimated value of \$30,000. In addition, \$60,000 worth of miscellaneous equipment was seized in the search as well.

The discovery was made by task force members as a result from a lengthy investigation and serving a search warrant at the location.

No information was released on the location of the warehouse, the date of the bust, or name of potential suspects. Also no suspects were arrested, according to a statement issued by LASD.

Most of the plastic goods were found intact. However, some had been ground down in an effort to make them untraceable.

The PITTF is a division at the Industry Sheriff's Station that is completely funded by the City, and has been in operation since September of 2011. Most of the stolen and recovered plastics are

pallets, trays, shelves, baskets, and totes (collapsible crates) from grocery stores, pizza places, bakery industry, restaurants, beverage companies, and shipping and receiving companies.

Once thieves collect the plastic, they take it to sites where it can be grounded and then sold to plastic manufacturers.

Since it's creation, task force agents have recovered and returned over 7 million dollars in

Spot drug houses

on how to spot a marijuana grow house.

A "marijuana grow house" is typically a house located in a suburban area that is industrialized to grow and distribute Marijuana. This process includes bypassing the electrical meter by way of expensive and high grade electrical equipment or leading a wire to the power line before the meter. The houses must be maintained at a certain temperature as well to ensure the crops growth. Due to this, the houses can possess the ability to create an immediate fire hazard with all the electricity being generated through amateur wiring. However, fire hazards aren't the only downside to grow houses. Most of the time, growers are involved in gang activity which brings the threat of violent crime into your neighborhood. Grow houses can also cause property values to drop which can put a strain on homeowners in the area.

According to the DEA and

FBI, marijuana is a multi-billion dollar industry which includes profits made from the "legal" dispensaries across the states that have legalized it for medical purposes. Grow house owner's supply to every market as well as including the medical marijuana dispensaries and the current black market, making marijuana an incredibly lucrative crop and one of the most easily accessible drugs.

The Riverside Sheriff Dept. has recently released a statement giving tips on how to spot a grow house. Some of these tips include looking out for windows that are covered from the interior, lights and televisions on timers, subjects moving in commercial grade electrical equipment during the late night or early morning hours, no signs of normal residential occupation, and the smell of marijuana emitting from the home.

It's also advised to never approach someone who you may think is operating a grow house for your own safety, as owners are usually criminals involved in

some form of gang activity and do not want anybody interfering with their operation.

If you or someone you know suspects a home of being a grow house, you are strongly

advised to call calling Deputy Javier Morando at the Jurupa Valley Station at (951) 955-2600 or the Riverside County Sheriff's Department's dispatch center at (951)776-1099.

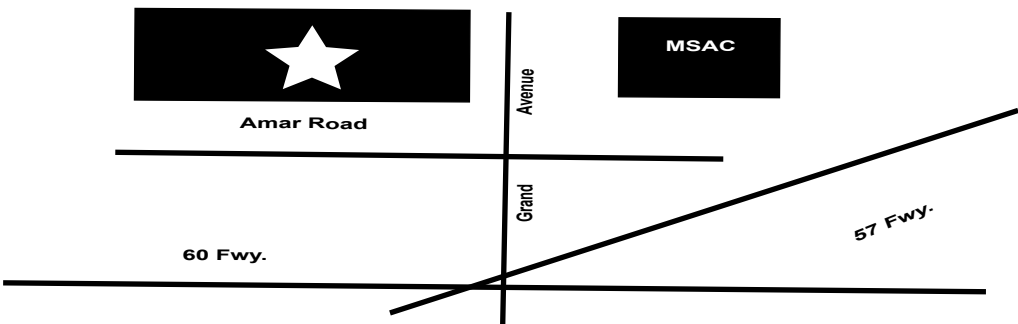

Impressions Of Israel

Recently a group from our church left on a 12 day trip to Israel. We left on the day after Easter and returned about a week ago. The most frequent question people ask is, "What were your impressions of Israel?"



One of the most striking things about Israel is how similar it is to California! The geography and climate are very similar to ours! Israel has a "west coast" just like we do. They have the coastline of the Mediterranean Sea, just like we have our coastline of the Pacific Ocean. They also have a flat coastal plain just like we do. Tel Aviv is very similar to Long Beach, Seal Beach and Huntington Beach. Further inland, a ridge of

mountains rises in the east. Jerusalem is located at about 2,500 feet above sea level. Our mountains are higher than that. But, in both Israel and in southern California, the mountains separate the ocean from the desert. As you go further east into Israel, the land drops off into the Jordan Valley. The hillsides around the Dead Sea looks just like the hillsides above Palm Springs. It is a desolate, dry desert landscape. The Jordan Valley looks a lot like Palm Springs and the desert city of Jericho looks just like Indio, California, with acres of Date Palm trees. We have the Salton Sea just like Israel has the Dead Sea. Both have no outlet and both have large mineral deposits in them. Both of them are below sea level. In fact, the Dead Sea is over 1,000 feet below sea level! The Jordan River is similar to

Plastic task force seize 30k of stolen plastic

stolen trademarked plastic products to victimized businesses, and arrested over 71 suspects involved in the theft and possession of stolen trademarked products. Sheriff's task force agents have also seized numerous pieces of equipment that were used in the illegal activities, and have also identified and shut down over 29 locations that were being used to stow, grind,

and prime for sale, intact and/or ground stolen trademarked plastic products. "The victims of these thefts are hard working businesspeople contributing products and services to their customers, as well as jobs to the economy. The enormous cost to businesses as a result of these thefts is ultimately paid by consumers through increases in prices for goods and services," said Industry Sheriff's Station Captain Mike Claus in a news release.

"Clearly, the enormity of the loss just in Los Angeles County could easily exceed \$10 million dollars a year. I have been contacted by Los Angeles County and even worldwide global businesses who have made it clear that this is an epidemic that has never been addressed. These businesspeople are grateful that the Sheriff's Department has taken a leadership role in addressing this issue and educating the public about it. While expressing gratitude, some busi-

ness owners explained that their losses had been so huge, that had the thefts continued, they most likely would have had to go out of business." "We will continue to find these

stolen products and return them to their rightful owners, and the people responsible will be arrested and addressed by the criminal justice system," said Captain Claus.

Woman convicted of torture

of torture, one felony count of aggravated mayhem, and a sentencing enhancement for the personal use of a knife. She faces a maximum sentence of life in state prison with the possibility of parole at her sentencing June 28, 2013 at the Central Justice Center in Santa Ana.

At the time of the crime, Kieu and 60-year-old John Doe had a romantic relationship and lived together in Garden Grove.

On the night of July 11, 2011, Kieu and John Doe had an argument over the possibility of a friend staying with them at their home at a later date. The defendant then prepared dinner for the victim and laced it with Ambien without the victim's knowledge.

At approximately 9 p.m., John Doe became tired as a result of being drugged and went to bed. As he slept in his bed, Kieu tied the victim's legs and arms to the four corners of the bed with nylon ropes. When John Doe awoke, the defendant pulled down his pants, grabbed the victim's penis, and severed it with a knife.

Kieu then took the penis to the kitchen, threw it into the garbage disposal, turned it on, and mutilated the organ.

After attacking the victim, Kieu called 911 and reported that John Doe was bleeding. John Doe then spoke to police dispatch and reported that his penis had been cut off by the defendant.

Garden Grove Police Department officers, who investigated this case, arrived at the scene and John Doe was transported to University of California, Irvine

Medical Center. He was released from the hospital after undergoing emergency surgery.

During the trial, the defense argued that Kieu was suffering from depression and other mental health issues, and therefore should not be found guilty because she did not have the requisite intent to complete the crime.

Senior Deputy District Attorney John Christl of the Special Prosecutions Unit is prosecuting this case.
