Walnut Library Closes For Rehab

Walnut – Due to a major renovation, the Los Angeles County Library in Walnut closed its doors for five months on June 7, according to the City of Walnut. The cost of the project is estimated at \$945,000.

“Walnut is grateful to the L.A. County Board of Supervisors for approving this project to enhance our community,” said Mayor

UCSB Student Remembered As Smart, Fun, Loving

Chino Hills – Known as Katie to her friends, Chino Hills resident Katherine Cooper was fondly remembered by those who knew her – and many who didn’t – in the days following the tragic shooting rampage near UC Santa Barbara.

“A lot of us remember her as someone that was very caring, very kind,” Brandon Andre told KABC-TV. “She was very strong in her personality ... Everywhere she went, she left an impression. People just loved her ...,” said Andre, who was Cooper’s friend

and one-time prom date.

Cooper, 22, was one of six UCSB students killed during the April 23 incident in Isla Vista, the Santa Barbara community of UCSB, where Cooper was about to graduate with a degree in History.

According to news reports, Cooper was standing with a small group outside the Alpha Phi sorority house around 9:30 p.m. when 22-year old Elliot Rodger approached the front door, pounding on it to gain entrance. When the door was not answered, Rodger reportedly walked over to Cooper’s

group and opened fire, killing Cooper and fellow Delta Delta Delta sorority sister, 19-year old Veronika Weiss of Westlake Village, Calif. A third girl was also injured.

Friends and neighbors of Cooper remember her as a very friendly and fun-loving girl. Neighbor Sandra Betancourt told The Press-Enterprise that Cooper was “so pretty, but not conceited,” referring to the young woman’s personality. Betancourt recalled Cooper often

Former Public Defender Sentenced To One Year

Upland – An Upland attorney was sentenced in June to one year and one day in federal prison for stealing \$129,795 from the Social Security Administration (SSA) after her grandmother died in 2000.

Audrey Owens, 61, was a deputy public defender for Riverside County, retiring just

last September. She pled guilty in March to two counts of theft of government property, admitting that she swindled the government for 12 years. On Mon., June 2, Owens was sentenced by United States District Judge, Virginia A. Phillips.

According to court documents, from June 2000 through August 2012, Owens fraudulently obtained Social Security

benefits intended for her grandmother, who died in May 2000. After her grandmother’s death, Owens changed the address of a joint account she shared with her grandmother and continued to receive the dead woman’s payments.

Owens “devised and executed a plan to illicitly obtain

Restoration Of VLF Funds Still In Limbo

Eastvale – The fate of a legislative bill expected to restore Vehicle License Fees (VLF) to four Riverside County cities remains in limbo, though recent activity indicates it’s again progressing through the legislature. However, at least one of the four cities – Eastvale – has essentially thrown in the towel.

Sponsored by California Sen. Richard Roth (D-Riverside), Senate Bill 69 replaces a similar bill (SB56) that previously stalled in the legislature. Last May, SB69 passed the state senate and proceeded to the state assembly, where the bill awaits a final vote.

The bill proposes to move an estimated \$18 to \$19 million in property tax money normally marked for education to the

four Riverside County cities. It stems in part from a 2011 decision by California lawmakers – via SB89 – to shift millions in vehicle license fee funds from cities as part of the prison realignment process that shifted these costs from the state to counties. The shifting of VLF funds was done to help counties absorb these new costs. However, the funds came from those normally given to cit-

ies, removal of which greatly impacted newer municipalities that typically rely heavily upon VLF funds.

Locally, the four cities most affected by the shifting of VLF funds were Eastvale, Jurupa Valley, Wildomar, and Menifee, all of which have incorporated since 2008. The four cities

Orange County Sheriff's investigators have identified the deceased as Mark Sheer, 55; Lydia Sheer, 54; Michael Sheer, 21, and Amy Sheer, 15; all related and living together in the home. The Sheer family was very involved at Mount of Olives Lutheran Church, where Mark and Lydia reportedly taught Bible Studies.

Neighbors allegedly heard

gunshots, or "fireworks," on Memorial Day and in the early morning hours of Mon., May 26, sheriff's deputies responded to reports of the same and a male yelling in the area near Pacific Hills Road. Deputies patrolled the area for several minutes but were unable to locate anything to substantiate the report. Sheriff's were again contacted on Tuesday when a relative was not able to reach the family. The two incidents appear related.

According to a news release from the Sheriff's Department, preliminary evidence suggests that Michael Sheer is suspected of shooting his father, mother and sister with a shotgun prior to turning the gun on himself.

Reports from neighbors, friends and fellow church parishioners are filled with shock and dismay regarding this highly-praised family. Perhaps they will never know the reasons for this tragedy, although authorities are investigating motive.

significant amounts of SSA benefits intended for her deceased grandmother," prosecutors wrote in a sentencing

memo filed with the court. "Indeed, within just one week of her grandmother's death, [Owens] sprang her plan into action by immediately removing her father's name off of the

[grandmother's] Kansas City account and changing the address of record to her own address in Upland. This allowed her to continue to receive SSA benefits, undetected, for

over 12 years, totaling more than \$129,000. She was only stopped when SSA began to suspect fraud – otherwise, the theft would have likely continued indefinitely and resulted in

even greater losses."

The investigation in this case was conducted by the Social Security Administration, Office of the Inspector General, Office of Investigations.

have worked for the past two plus years – sharing a lobbyist – in trying to get the funds restored.

Eastvale, however, recently decided not to renew its contract with the lobbyist, saying doing so was "throwing good money at bad. We have better uses for that money," Mayor Ike Bootsma told The Press-Enterprise. Bootsma says he's not

optimistic that if SB69 passes, that Governor Brown will sign it, thus the City is not counting on restoration of the lost funds.

Michele Nissen, Public Information Officer for Eastvale, says City officials have been prudent in their budgeting without relying on the VLF funds.

"We have been very conservative in our budget decisions (past, present and future) and have not counted on getting the VLF money back. The major impact to the City is that the

loss of VLF money takes away our ability to provide more police officers and other services," said Nissen.

In particular, the loss of VLF funds was hardest on Jurupa Valley, which was the last of the four cities to incorporate in 2011, just two days after the shifting of VLF funds by the state. The new city lost nearly half of its general fund budget during its first year. It has since cut expenses and delayed some payments to Riverside

County. But without restoration of the VLF funds, the city expects to run out of money by July 2015. As a precaution, city officials reluctantly began the lengthy disincorporation process this past January.

However, other options to

make up the lost monies – including a possible public vote for an annual assessment on property – are also under review. It is unknown at this time whether either option will save Jurupa Valley from potential disincorporation.

playing with neighborhood kids and walking her dogs.

The family reportedly moved into the quiet Chino Hills cul-de-sac near Ruben S. Ayala High School about 17 years ago, where Cooper attended Rolling Ridge Elementary School, Canyon Hills Junior High School and later graduated from Ayala High School in 2010 before heading to UCSB.

Allen Borcharding, a 7th Grade Science teacher at Canyon Hills Junior High School in Chino Hills, said she was "more than an excellent student" in his class. "She was one of 2,500 students I've taught over the years, but Katie was a stand-out," Borcharding said to The Associated Press.

Reports about the shooter said he was a young man with an apparent hatred toward girls and women, whom he said had rejected him. Videos posted by the suspect on YouTube seem to confirm this.

In a transcript reported by the Los Angeles Times of one video, titled "Elliot Rodger's Retribution," Rodger recounts his rejection by women, saying "you girls have never been attracted to me. I don't know why you girls aren't attracted to me but I will punish you all for it. It's an injustice, a crime ..." Rodger continues saying that he's "still a virgin, never even kissed a girl" and that "college is the time when everyone experiences those things such as sex and fun and pleasure. In those years I've had to rot in loneliness, it's not fair."

Later in the same video, Rodger turns his anger toward sorority girls, whom he called "spoiled" and "stuck-up."

"On the day of retribution, I am going to enter the hottest sorority house at UCSB and I will slaughter every single spoiled, stuck-up, blonde I see inside there," Rodger states in the video. "All those girls I've desired so much. They have all rejected me and looked down on me as an inferior man if I

ever made a sexual advance toward them, while they throw themselves at these obnoxious brutes."

After the sorority shootings, the suspect reportedly drove away in his BMW where he continued firing, injuring some and killing Christopher Michaels-Martinez, 20, who was inside the I.V. Deli. Prior to the shootings, Rodger had stabbed his two roommates, George Chen, 19, and Cheng Yuan "James" Hong, 20, and their friend, Weihai "David" Wang, 20, in the apartment they shared. Following his rampage, authorities say Rodger shot himself in his car as police closed in.

In the days that followed, multiple vigils were held for the victims, including a large vigil of over 17,000 gathered at UCSB to honor the six victims. Speakers included UC President, Janet Napolitano, and Richard Martinez, the father of one of the shooting victims. Martinez' passionate voice about his son's killing in the days after the tragedy has again triggered the gun

control debate in this country.

"It's time to stop the gun violence. Our children deserve a land free from fear," Martinez told the large crowd. "It's almost become a normal thing for us to accept this. It's not normal. Any of us who grew up in the 50s, 60s, 40s, know that life doesn't have to be like this. So why should it be like this for you people who are young now?"

The crowd later joined Martinez in chanting, "Not one

more."

A small vigil was also held in Chino Hills for Katie Cooper. The May 28 vigil at Calle San Marcos Park was attended by about 200. On hand was Cooper's father, Dan Cooper, who wanted mourners to remember Katie as a caring person.

"The beauty of her you will hear about now and in the weeks ahead is the image of God she has painted in our heads," he said.



Three Inland Men Sentenced For Rooftop Bank Heists

Inland Empire – Three Inland Empire men will be sent to prison for rooftop bank heists that occurred in Diamond Bar and Rowland Heights

Alceu Johnny Andreis, 46, of Banning, Lucian Gabriel Isaia, 33 of Beaumont, and Laurentiu Penescu, 39, of

Yucaipa, all pled guilty to conspiracy to commit bank burglary and attempted bank burglary in January. They were sentenced on Mon., June 9, with Andreis receiving a 51-month jail term, and Isaia and Penescu receiving 37-month terms. All men were also ordered to serve a three-year supervised released post

prison.

By using power tools to cut through the roofs of buildings in order to gain entrance into bank vaults, the trio apparently did not learn from their mistakes. Andreis, Isaia and Penescu were reportedly imprisoned almost a decade ago for the same type of burglaries in Riverside County that

netted more than \$3.5 million in cash and goods. They had the knowledge to attempt the bank heists.

Along with two other accomplices, the men were arrested in April 2013 following a year-long investigation by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. Dean Muniz, 46, of Fontana, was sentenced

recently to ten years in federal prison; and Daniel Soto, 37, of Riverside will be sentenced on June 30.

The five men are linked to burglaries at the East West Bank in Rowland Heights in 2011, the BBCN Bank in Diamond Bar in 2012, and the Citibank Bank in Diamond Bar in 2013.


