Grand Avenue Beautification Project To Start Soon

Diamond Bar – If you frequent the area around Grand Avenue in the City of Diamond Bar, you will start to see some major changes taking place as the City begins to beautify its gateway in grand design.

According to the City of Diamond Bar, the Grand Avenue

Local High School Teacher Arrested For Kidnapping

Altadena – The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) Altadena Station detectives arrested John Edward Maust, 34, a local high school teacher, for kidnapping three juveniles after asking them for

a ride.

According to an LASD news release, three 17-year old juveniles were driving in the area of Ganesha Avenue and East Mariposa Street in Altadena, on Sat., June 7 at approximately 9:35 p.m., when they recognized Maust, one of their high school

teacher's, standing on the sidewalk. When the juveniles stopped their vehicle to say hello, the teacher walked toward them and appeared to be intoxicated. The teacher then asked for a ride, to which the driver agreed. During the ride, a conversation with the teacher caused the driver to be-

come worried, and he pulled over. After the juveniles exited the car, the teacher said he wanted to go to "Jack in the Box," and ordered the juveniles back into the car. Fearing for their well-being, the

Walnut Library Closes For Five Months

The Walnut Library will close for five months starting June 8.

Walnut – Due to a major renovation, the Los Angeles County Library in Walnut will be closing its doors for five months beginning June 7, according to the City of Walnut. The cost of the project is estimated at \$945,000.

"Walnut is grateful to the L.A.

County Board of Supervisors for approving this project to enhance our community," said Mayor Antonio "Tony" Cartagena in a news release. "The Walnut Library is a vital resource for our families, students, and seniors, and we are excited to see the renovations that will take place."

The renovation will include a new floor plan to maximize

public space, new furniture, self-checkout technology, additional computers, a large group study room, a new teen area, new carpet and paint, ADA upgrades, a redesigned public meeting room and a digital display in the lobby.

later this summer. The federal grant will provide improvements to the intersections at Diamond Bar Boulevard, and Longview Drive, the primary portals into the City, including landscaping, paving, lighting, and public furnishing improvements.

Goals of the project will be to stimulate existing commercial centers, and rebrand

the City with an aesthetically pleasing environment. Through streetscapes, decorative pavements, median panels and rails, and pedestrian and accent lighting, the redesign will be the cornerstone for development guidelines for the entire City.

Earlier this year, the City held an Open House to enable residents and businesses to provide input on design concepts. Artistic renderings

portray Diamond Bar's history amid beautiful colors and patterns. Landscaping designs will provide drought-resistant plants.

Along with public improvements of this magnitude come traffic delays. Look for alternative routes as this project gets underway, and look forward to the beautification of Grand Avenue, with completion scheduled for winter 2015.

Former public defender sentenced

curity Administration (SSA) after her grandmother died in 2000.

Audrey Owens, 61, was a deputy public defender for Riverside County, retiring just last September. She pled guilty in March to two counts of theft of government property, admitting that she swindled the government for 12 years. On Mon., June 2, Owens was sentenced by United States District Judge, Virginia A. Phillips.

According to court documents, from June 2000 through August 2012, Owens fraudulently ob-

tained Social Security benefits intended for her grandmother, who died in May 2000. After her grandmother's death, Owens changed the address of a joint account she shared with her grandmother and continued to receive the dead woman's payments.

Owens "devised and executed a plan to illicitly obtain significant amounts of SSA benefits intended for her deceased grandmother," prosecutors wrote in a sentencing memo filed with the court. "Indeed, within just one week of her grandmother's death, [Owens] sprang her plan into action by immediately re-

moving her father's name off of the [grandmother's] Kansas City account and changing the address of record to her own address in Upland. This allowed her to continue to receive SSA benefits, undetected, for over 12 years, totaling more than \$129,000. She was only stopped when SSA began to suspect fraud – otherwise, the theft would have likely continued indefinitely and resulted in even greater losses."

The investigation in this case was conducted by the Social Security Administration, Office of the Inspector General, Office of Investigations.

High school teacher arrested

juveniles re-entered the car. It was at this time the teacher brandished a knife at them.

During the ordeal, one of the juveniles was able to call 911. Shortly after, the teacher saw the LASD helicopter overhead, and ordered the driver to stop the car. The teacher then got out of the car and fled the location.

On Sun., June 8, at approximately 1:30 p.m., Maust walked into Altadena Sheriff's Station lobby, where he surrendered without incident. The suspect was

arrested for kidnapping, false imprisonment, and criminal threats. He was booked at Crescenta Valley Station and is being held in lieu of \$100,000 bail.

\$3.5 million embezzlement

monitoring programs to courts and probation departments, plead guilty this week to federal charges of embezzling well over \$3 million from the company over the course of two years.

According to the U.S. District Attorney's Office, Steven A. Hagstrom, 37, of Anaheim, who was an accountant and then controller of the Irvine-based Sentinel Offender Services, LLC, plead guilty on Tues., June 3, to one count of embezzlement before United States District Judge, David O. Carter.

As controller of Sentinel, Hagstrom had access to Sentinel's bank accounts where fines, court fees and restitution payments from criminal defendants were held in trust. The accounts also held money

paid to Sentinel for services provided to state and federal court systems. Beginning in early 2012 and continuing until April 2013, Hagstrom transferred approximately \$3,338,197 from Sentinel's bank accounts to bank accounts he controlled, where they could be used for his own benefit.

Judge Carter is scheduled to sentence Hagstrom on Sept. 29. The embezzlement count carries a statutory maximum sentence of ten years in federal prison. About half of the embezzled money has already been returned to Sentinel, and Hagstrom has agreed to make full restitution to his former employer.

The investigation into Hagstrom was conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Internal Revenue Service Criminal Division.

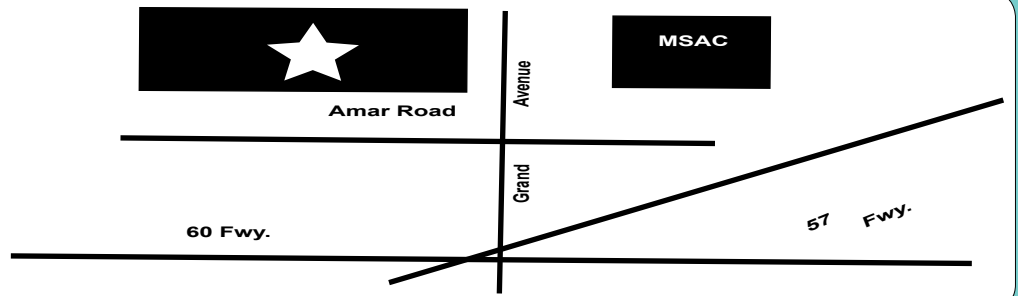
